Fr. Kevin Walsh, pastor of Precious Blood Church in Culpeper, VA, was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Arlington in 1992, the same year in which he obtained a Master of Arts in Theology from Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, Maryland. After ordination he served as Parochial Vicar in several parishes, working extensively in Hispanic ministry. From 2000-02 he served as

Chaplain and Director of Campus Minis-try at Marymount University in Arlington. He has been a pastor since 2004. (See complete bio on our website). In addition to native fluency in Spanish, Fr. Walsh is conversationally fluent in Italian and French, and "gets by" in German and Portuguese. He also reads Latin, Classical Greek and Biblical Hebrew, and put his multilingual skills to good use when he earned a License in Sacred Theology with a concentration in Biblical Theology from the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome in 2016, graduating *Magna Cum Laude*. After finishing his studies, he returned to the Arlington Diocese in 2016 to serve as Pastor of Precious Blood Parish until the present. Fr. Walsh, a trained Scripture scholar, will share his extensive knowledge and understanding of the Gospel of Luke, helping priests prepare to preach on this Gospel throughout the Sundays in 2025.
