Submission Guidelines for Gulf Coast Catholic Magazine

1. Identifying Possible Magazine Stories

Deciding if a story is suitable for the magazine is not a one size fits all rule. Instead, it involves a bit of reflecting on its impact on you. If you find yourself retelling the story or thinking about it often, chances are, you've found a gem. These are the stories that resonate and should be shared.

Once you've shared your idea, the managing editor, will evaluate the story and determine if it has the elements necessary for a compelling magazine article, and reach back out to you. 2. Elements for Magazine Articles

Relevance to our Catholic Faith: Stories ought to highlight our Catholic traditions and share inspiring accounts of individuals who are Courageously Living the Gospel. This can be through various aspects of family life, prayer life, and community life.

Inspirational and Educational: Articles should help Catholics know, live, and share their faith, offering resources that foster personal growth as disciples and facilitate the sharing of the Good News of Jesus Christ.
