Basic Procedures for Submitting the Incident Report

1. The Parish/School Administrator or Pastor will complete PART I, the incident report, sign and date where indicated, and give the form to the participant.

2. The participant or participant's parents/guardian will complete PART II, and forward it to K&K Insurance Group, Inc.
3. Coverage under this policy is excess/secondary. If the student has other insurance, make the medical providers aware that the other insurance should be billed as the primary insurance and this policy as the secondary insurance. If this is done, the secondary insurance will be billed by the medical providers with the necessary forms.
4. Failure to provide itemized medical bills and the primary insurance Explanation of Benefits will cause a delay in the claim process.

To the Participant/Parent/Guardian:

Attach current itemized physician, hospital, or other provider's bills for accident medical expenses being claimed as well as the primary carrier's Explanation of Benefits showing their payments and denials. These bills must show the patient's name, condition (diagnosis), type of treatment given, date the expense was incurred and the charges made.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

- **In General, and specifically for residents of Arkansas, Illinois, Louisiana, Rhode Island and West Virginia:** Any person who knowingly presents a false or fraudulent claim for payment of a loss or benefit or knowingly presents false information in an application for insurance is guilty of a crime and may be subject to fines and confinement in prison.
- **For Residents of Alabama:** Any person who knowingly presents a false or fraudulent claim for payment of a loss or benefit or knowingly presents false information in an application for insurance is guilty of a crime and may be subject to restitution fines and confinement in prison, or any combination thereof.
- **For residents of Colorado:** It is unlawful to knowingly provide false, incomplete, or misleading facts or information to an insurance company for the purpose of defrauding or attempting to defraud the company. Penalties may include imprisonment, fines, denial of insurance, and civil damages. Any insurance company or agent of an insurance company who knowingly provides false, incomplete, or misleading facts or information to a policyholder or claimant for the purpose of defrauding or attempting to defraud the policyholder or claimant with regard to a settlement or award payable from insurance proceeds shall be reported to the Colorado division of insurance within the department of regulatory agencies.

- **For residents of Oregon:** Any person who knowingly and willfully presents a false or fraudulent claim for payment of a loss or benefit or who knowingly or willfully presents false information in an application for insurance may be guilty of a crime and may be subject to fines and confinement in prison.
- **For residents of Maryland:** Any person who knowingly or willfully presents a false or fraudulent claim for payment of a loss or benefit or who knowingly or willfully presents false information in an application for insurance is guilty of a crime and may be subject to fines and confinement in prison.
- **For residents of New Jersey:** Any person who includes any false or misleading information on an application for an insurance policy is subject to criminal and civil penalties.
- **For residents of New Mexico:** ANY PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY PRESENTS A FALSE OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM FOR PAYMENT OF A LOSS OR BENEFIT OR KNOWINGLY PRESENTS FALSE INFORMATION IN AN APPLICATION FOR INSURANCE IS GUILTY OF A CRIME AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO CIVIL FINES AND CRIMINAL PENALTIES.
